














3. Holes and Tears: Usable area

4. Hair: No embedded hair


cannot have holes or tears

5. Irregular Edges: After trimming


edges, graft is still too small



- **8. Too Thick:** Skin will not mesh consistently if too thick
- **9. Too Thin:** Skin will not withstand meshing if too thin
- **10. Too Thick:** Skin will not mesh consistently if too thick
- 11. Other: Scars, raised moles and tattoos cannot be present







1. Ideal Size: Transplantable skin graft for burns is 300 cm<sup>2</sup>

This means if the width is 10 cm, the length must be at least 30 cm

However, we can process grafts as small as 150 cm<sup>2</sup> with a minimum width of 5 cm

2. Desired Thickness: Approximately 0.25–0.50 mm
